

## Troyes – some FAQ

**Q:** Artisan - converts 1 IP into 6 money. This means I'd get 6 money for each 1 of my IP - but I think you mean you must actually "pay" (= loose) one IP for 6 money, is that correct?

**A:** Yes

**Q:** Migrant Workers - "... free space on the lowest level ..." That is at the bottom level **only**, but probably you mean "at the lowest level available", that's how we played it, makes no sense otherwise.

**A:** Yes no sense otherwise.

**Q:** If a player cannot execute an event, they (btw, politically correct form instead of "he") loose 2 VP's (none if they don't have any). If they cannot beat a black die, they loose 2 VP's - what, if they don't have any? Guess same as before, but this is not mentioned in the rules.

**A:** If you don't have VP, you don't loose VP.

**Q:** Can you expel yourself from a principal building?

**A:** Why not?

**Q:** If you remove your expelled citizen (inexplicably called "Master" in the German rules) from a building, are you still protected from being expelled from this building for the remainder of the round? Maybe place one of your markers there instead?

**A:** You have protection if you have a meeple on lying the building.
